Approach	- 13 Km from Matiyari Chauraha, Faizabad Road, Chinhat, Lucknow ; 16 Km from Tehri Pulia Chauraha, Kursi Road, Lucknow

Number of families	- About 300

Any clinic/ Doctor available but closed)	- No regular availability , (One clinic is found of MBBS doctor,
Nearest Government hospital	- District Hospital Barabanki Lohia Hospital, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow (Both are approx. 22 Km from village)
Nearest Private hospital	- various hospitals at Dewa Road, Kursi Road (Approx. 8-10 Km)
